



Original Abstract Submission Information

AWIR invites Rheumatology Fellows and Trainees to submit abstracts of their original work, clinical cases or research findings. Interns and residents-in-training in an accredited program for an M.D., D.O., MMBS, or PhD degree, with a focus in rheumatology are also encouraged to submit.

Abstracts must include data on partial or completed clinical trials, observational studies, case studies, or clinical hypotheses.

Accepted abstracts will be invited to present live or virtually during AWIR 2022, on Saturday August 20th. Each presentation will be limited to less than 5 minutes. Accepted abstracts and presenters will be listed in the final AWIR2022 program.

AWIR 2022 will leverage a state-of-the-art app that will live stream the event, host E-Posters, virtual exhibits, polling, and networking.

- Submitted abstracts (350 words) are due for review by June 13, 2022.
- Please send abstracts to AWIR2022@awirgroup.org.
 - Please include a brief introduction, objective, methods and conclusion for research abstracts. Graphs, figures, and tables should be submitted in the same file as the abstract.
- Please submit a copy of your CV with the abstract, including the name of your academic institution and medical program.
- Notification of acceptance as a presenter will be by email within 10 business days.
- Presenters are invited to create E-posters of their presentations to be displayed in AWIR2022's Poster Hall on site at the Westin Hotel and in the app.
- Presenters are requested to record a short audio file introducing the E-poster and a professional photo (.jpeg or .gif). The audio file (120 seconds) will be embedded with the poster
- Final pdf files of your presentation, E-posters and audio files will need to be submitted by July 16th.
- Registration as an AWIR fellow, and registration to the AWIR2022 Conference are mandatory for submission.

- Fellows wishing to join AWIR as a member will need an attestation letter from their academic institution identifying them as a trainee.
