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

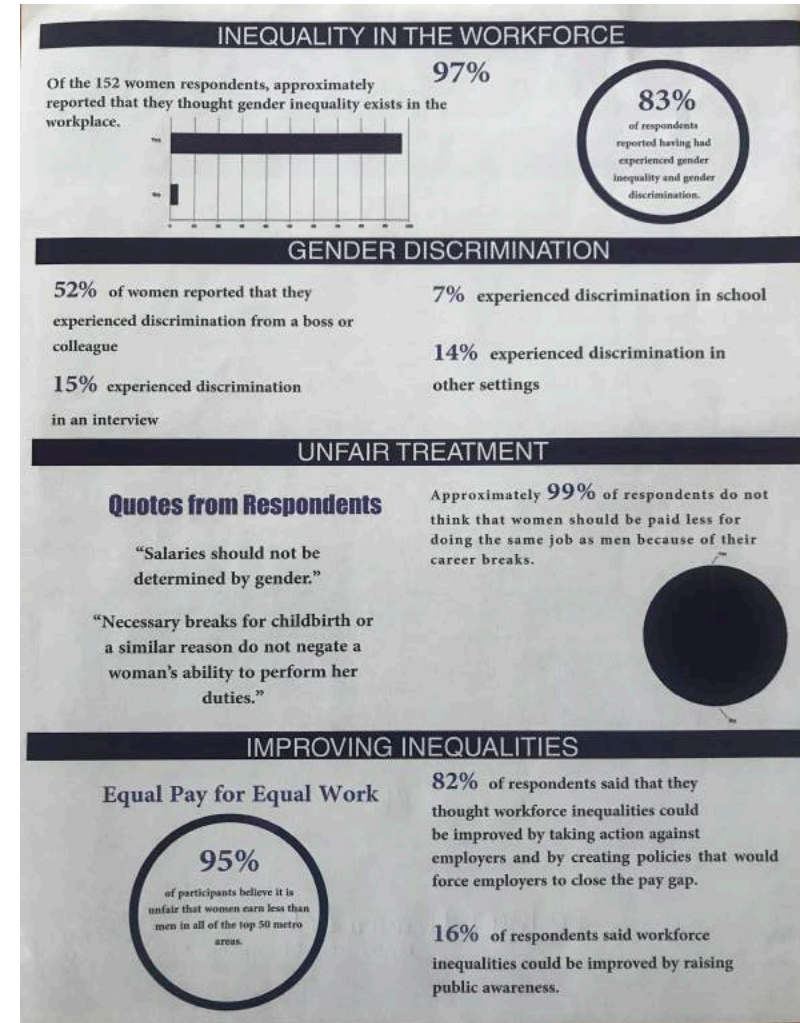
TELL CONGRESS TO SUP

SUPPORT STANDARDIZING PRIOR AUTHORIZATION REQUESTS - H.R. 3107
Urge your federal representatives to support streamlining prior authorization requests through use of electronic transmissions, HR 3107.
